As you are aware I act for Dr Louise Allan.

The tone of much of this correspondence has been threatening and intimidating, to the extent that it may breach section 474.17 of the *Criminal Code* (Commonwealth).

I am instructed to demand that you cease and desist from this behaviour. Any further such correspondence will, on my client's instructions, be referred to the appropriate authorities.

You allege defamation against my client and then, in my client's opinion, you have engaged in correspondence that is defamatory to her. Further, you have done nothing to progress the defamation action in the Supreme Court of Tasmania.

Please ensure that such correspondence ceases in order to avoid further action in that respect.

I am further instructed that you have taken issue with the publication of photographs by my client, which are old family photographs previously in the possession of your late husband. On my instructions no intellectual property issues arise with respect to those photographs and my client is free to use them as she wishes.
